## 9. Presidents Report:

- Brett pointed out that the RMS log book scheme may be being abused by a few members. It is therefore important that all members adhere to the rules governing the scheme since there is likely to be greater focus by the RMS than in recent times. Should any member be found to be openly flaunting the system the club is within its constitutional powers to withdraw membership. Obviously we do not want to go down that path, the scheme is there for all to use but according to information from one club magazine some Sydney drivers have been challenged and had to withdraw from the scheme.
- Brett is disappointed to understand that so far only a very few members have nominated to attend the Shepperton BBQ, with as many members as we currently have it is not a good reflection on the club, please contact Max if you can attend.
- Tathra Fire Appeal. Brett spoke about the recent tragic fires that had affected the Tathra community. He noted that at one recent BBQ event the CVMCE raised \$300 in donations which is outstanding. He also noted that 2EAR FM were running a 24 hour radio appeal on 3 and 4 April and that 2EC FM will be running a weekend appeal in late April. Brett proposed to the meeting that the club make up a donation to the value of \$1000 (taking into account the \$300 already raised). It was agreed that any donation was to go to the "right place and not just absorbed into community funds. 2EAR FM had already investigated this for their own fund raising appeal and deduced that a unique fund was set up by the Mayor of Bega as an accountable fund and this will be the destination of any donation the CVMCE makes. Discussion took place about increasing the donation amount to \$2000 in total.
