- CMC correspondence re vehicle ownership and RMS requirements (Terry Thompson – President)
- The use of a Heritage or Classic Vehicle is a CONTRACT between the registered vehicle owner and RMS.
- CVMCE is a CONDITION of that contract, ie, financial member
- As the CONTRACT is between the Registered Vehicle Owner and RMS, the ONUS always lies with the Vehicle Owner. Our inspectors have the right to demand proof that a member is financial – So, next time you take your vehicle to one of our inspectors, take your receipt
- As the CONTRACT is between the Registered Vehicle Owner and RMS, make sure our club records correctly identify the Vehicle Owner. Don't use your partners name if they are NOT the Registered Owner.
- Passing of Barry Reids wife Mary and Gordon Halliday.
Gordon's funeral, - he was well loved by family and friends.
- For some the CVMCE is more than an avenue for cheap rego, its also a great social group where enthusiasts can gather and talk about their motoring passion.
- Mark Beaver explained the renewal process for modified vehicles in the Club as the first renewals are now due.
- Ross Hayward raised the matter of the Historic and Classic scheme and sought information on how the extended trial was progressing. The CVMCE has not received any updates on how the scheme is progressing however we will keep in close contact with our CMC affiliate to get information as soon as it comes to hand.

MOTOR TORQUE

Mark Beaver provided the meeting with a very interesting history of his early work life as a science teacher and how he learnt about the mechanical side of messing about with cars from his father. In the course of his early car life he had quite a few second hand Holdens and managed to modify them with extractors and twin carbs as they fell in and out of his ownership.
