Membership Renewal

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 New membership applications or a change in membership details can only be accepted via the Application for Membership or Change of Details Form.
- 1.2 All Applications for Membership or Change of Details Forms must be emailed or posted to the Secretary. No other delivery method will be accepted.

2. PAYMENT

- 2.1 The CVMCE preferred payment method is for ONLINE EFT.
- 2.2 Bank Details: St George Bank, BSB 112 879, Acc #:056916341, Acc Name: CVMCE
- 2.3 When making an EFT transfer, please insert your surname or phone number into the REFERENCE FIELD2.4 Save your EFT transfer details as a .pdf and email your proof of payment to the Club Treasurer for processing.
- 2.5 Note, as your saved EFT transfer details are your proof of payment, no receipt will be issued unless asked for.
- 2.6 Members without electronic banking access may pay by cheque mailed to the Treasurer CVMCE, PO Box 684 Moruya NSW 2537 or by cash deposit at a St George Branch.
- 2.7 Membership will cease for Members who fail to renew their membership by the 30th June and will need to pay the appropriate joining fee for new members.

Rules for the conditional registration and use of Club Members' Vehicles under the NSW Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS), and modified Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS), hereinafter referred to as the Schemes.1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. The NSW Roads and Maritime Service (RMS) conditionally registers HVS and CVS vehicles under the Schemes, providing those vehicles with Compulsory Third Party insurance cover and limited access to the road network. HVS and CVS vehicles registered under the Schemes are exempt from the payment of stamp duty, motor vehicle tax and national charges.

2. ELIGIBILITY (cvmce.org.au contains links to the RMS website for specific eligibility details)

- 2.1 HVS and CVS vehicles must be 30 years of age or older as from the year of manufacture. Under CVS guidelines a replica vehicle or an Individually Constructed Vehicle that is 30 years of age or older (based on the build completion date) are included.
- 2.2 HVS vehicles must be in as close to original condition as possible, with no alterations except for safety features such as seat belts, turn indicators or period accessories and options, if desired.
- 2.3 CVS vehicles must not exceed 3.5 tonnes Gross Vehicle Mass, and not be a plant vehicle or trailer.
- 2.4 The registered operator of a conditionally registered HVS or CVS vehicle must be a current financial member of an RMS recognised Motor Club eg. CVMCE.
- 2.5 For CVS applicants, their Primary Club must be affiliated with an RMS Approved Organization. CVMCE is affiliated with the Council of Motor Clubs Inc, which is an RMS Approved Organization.
- 2.6 When a member's vehicle is first registered or registration is renewed under the Schemes, the Club's Responsible Person must certify that the HVS vehicle is eligible for the Scheme and that the member is financial. However, CVS vehicle eligibility is determined by an RMS Approved Organization's Eligibility Committee. In this case, only Primary Club financial membership is certified by the Primary Club's Responsible Person.
- 2.7 The RMS has formally notified the Club that the Club will be held responsible for its members' strict compliance with all conditions imposed. Where a member does not comply, the Club may decline to confirm HVS vehicle eligibility and financial membership as required at 2.6 above.

3. VEHICLE ROADWORTHINESS

- 3.1 An HVS vehicle operating under the Schemes must be declared as being in a safe operating condition by a Responsible Person appointed by the Club Committee. The Responsible Person must have relevant mechanical knowledge.
- 3.2 A CVS vehicle operating under the Schemes must be inspected by an RMS Authorized Examiner at an Authorized Inspection Station as follows:

* To establish a conditional registration, an Authorized Unregistered Vehicle Inspection report must be presented to an RMS Approved Organisation.

This will consist of a Safety Check, Identity Check and Design Check.* To renew a conditional registration, a Safety Check report completed by an Authorised Examiner must be presented to an RMS Approved

Organisation.

4. VEHICLE USE

- 4.1. The vehicle may be used for CVMCE Club events, events organised by another Club or a recognised community organisation or personal use

4.2. The RMS Log Book Scheme allows HVS and CVS vehicles to be used for up to 60 days of personal use each year, outside of Club organised events. Vehicle use must be recorded in a Log Book issued at an RMS Registry or Service Centre.

4.3. If a member wishes to attend an event organised by another Club or a recognised community organisation, the member shall notify their Primary Club Official in advance. The Club Official will acknowledge the advice and record the attendance in the Day Book. If a personal invitation has been issued to a Club member, the member should provide the Club Official with a copy of this invitation.

4.4. Notice to the Club Official is not required when utilizing the 60 Day Trial Log Book Scheme.

5. MEMBERS' PERSONAL RECORDS

5.1. If a vehicle is not participating in the RMS 60 Day Trial Log Book Scheme, a personal record should still be kept by the registered operator. All movements of the vehicle on public roads should be documented.

6. RESERVATIONS

6.1. The CVMCE reserves the right to alter this document to accord with any new RMS provisions, which may occur at any time.
