| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All cars must be pre-registered with the organiser to participate in the car show along the Festival Boulevard (Clarinda Street) on Friday 12 January 2018</li><li>• Entrants in the <i>Classic and Heritage Vehicle Show</i> will access the display via Clarinda Street South, where participants will be guided to designated areas for display</li><li>• Participants <b>MUST</b> arrive for bump-in between 8am and 9am on Friday 12 January</li><li>• The <i>Classic and Heritage Vehicle Show</i> will run from 9am until 4pm, no early exit will be permitted without prior consent from the event organisers</li><li>• All vehicles including motorcycles must have current road registration.</li><li>• <b><u>Car show identification labels will be provided by event organisers and must be displayed clearly.</u></b></li><li>• No motorcycle colours are to be worn during the car show.</li><li>• Drivers may be breathalysed. Drivers must have zero blood alcohol content.</li><li>• All passengers including children must be restrained when riding in a vehicle.</li><li>• Smoking or the consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the car show.
